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## **DAY-TO-DAY ITINERARY**

### **Day 1: Windhoek- (1 night)**

Welcome to Namibia and the capital city of Windhoek. On arrival you will be met by your guide at the Hosea Kutako International airport and driven to your accommodation, check-in and settle in, enjoy a relaxing afternoon

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### **Day 2: Okonjima Plains Camp- (1 night)**

Depart Windhoek after breakfast and travel north toward the central plains of Namibia. The drive takes approximately 3–4 hours, passing through open savanna landscapes.

#### **When you're there:**

Okonjima is home to the AfriCat Foundation and offers an excellent introduction to Namibia's wildlife conservation efforts. Depending on arrival time, enjoy a guided nature drive or visit the AfriCat project to learn about large carnivore conservation. Relax at the lodge and take in the tranquil bush surroundings. On your way out, stopover at **Ombu village** to meet the **Ovaherero people**.

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### **Day 3: Ongula Homestead (Ovamboland) - (1 night)**

Continue north into Ovamboland, a culturally rich and densely populated region near the Angolan border. The landscape changes to flat plains dotted with homesteads and fields.

#### **When you're there:**

Ongula Homestead offers an authentic cultural experience rooted in **Oshiwambo** traditions. Enjoy a guided village walk or cultural interaction, gaining insight into local customs, daily life, and history. The evening is spent relaxing at the lodge, surrounded by peaceful rural scenery.

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### Day 4 & 5: Kaokoland- (2 nights)

Travel northwest into the remote and dramatic wilderness of Kaokoland, one of Namibia's most untouched regions. This is a long but rewarding drive through increasingly rugged terrain.

#### When you're there:

Kaokoland is known for its vast landscapes, **Himba communities**, and true sense of remoteness. Activities may include visits to **Himba villages** (conducted respectfully), nature drives through dry riverbeds, and time to absorb the stark beauty of this isolated region. Expect wide horizons, silence, and exceptional night skies.

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### Day 6: Damaraland- (1 night)

Journey south into Damaraland, a region characterised by ancient geology, granite outcrops, and desert-adapted wildlife.

#### When you're there:

Explore highlights such as Twyfelfontein's UNESCO-listed rock engravings, the Organ Pipes, and Burnt Mountain and stopover at the **Damara living museum** to meet the Damara people. Nature drives may reveal desert-adapted elephant, giraffe, and Hartmann's mountain zebra. Enjoy one of Namibia's most striking sunset landscapes.

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### Day 7 & 8: Etosha National Park – South- (2 nights)

Travel east toward Etosha National Park, entering via the southern gate. The drive transitions from rugged terrain to open plains.

#### When you're there:

Etosha offers exceptional game viewing centred around its iconic salt pan and numerous waterholes. Enjoy guided game drives in search of elephant, lion, rhino, giraffe, zebra, springbok, and a wide variety of birdlife. Evening relaxation at the lodge allows you to reflect on classic safari experiences.

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**Day 9 & 10: Swakopmund-** (2 nights)

After breakfast, depart Etosha and head south-west toward the Atlantic coast. The climate cools as the desert meets the ocean.

**When you're there:**

Swakopmund is a charming coastal town with strong German influences, offering a contrast to the wilderness. Explore Swakopmund and nearby Walvis Bay, including the lagoon and its rich birdlife. Optional activities include a marine cruise, quad biking, scenic flights, or a Sandwich Harbour excursion. Enjoy the town's cafés, restaurants, and seaside atmosphere.

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**Day 11 & 12: Sossusvlei (Namib Desert)-** (2 nights)

Travel south into the Namib Desert, passing through ever-changing desert scenery, mountain passes, and open gravel plains.

Early morning excursions take you into Sossusvlei at sunrise, the best time to experience the towering red dunes. Visit iconic sites such as Deadvlei and Dune 45 and enjoy guided interpretation of the desert's unique ecology and geology. Afternoons are at leisure to relax and enjoy the vast desert silence.
